1. ALBERT HALL CAR PARK

Run on the spot for 30 seconds and then stretch legs.

After which Albert is Albert Hall named?

F: Albert van Zetten, Australian politician and the current Mayor of Launceston.

G: Prince Albert, who got married to Queen Victoria in 1840.

H: Albert Thurgood, AFL and Essendon legend. The first footy player to kick 50 goals in a season.

PRAY: Say thank you to God for the people who are with you and that He cares for you.

2. THE MONKEYS

Do windmill arms for 30 seconds and then stretch your arms.

From which country did the monkeys originally come from?

M: Germany **N:** Peru **O:** Japan

PRAY: Say thank you to God for all the beautiful creatures He has made and pray that He will help us to look after the environment.

3. THE FOUNTAIN

Run around the fountain 3 times.

What three types of animals can be seen on the fountain?

PRAY: Say thank you to God for your teachers and pray, that the Lord will be with them, refresh and encourage them as they teach you over a distance.

PRAY: Say thank you to God for the people who care for us: nurses, doctors, police, ambulance officers, fire people and politicians and pray that God will look after them.

Do ten star jumps.

PRAY: Say thank you to God for your friends and pray that He keep them and their families safe, healthy and happy.

8. JOHN HART CONSERVATORY

Sit down on the steps and take a breath.
